Important Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria for Admission to Under-Graduate Courses—B.A., B.Com. and B.Sc.-I

- 1. The eligibility criteria for admission to B.A, B.Com and B.Sc. in the first year is strictly as per the latest ordinances/guidelines/calendar notified by the HP University/Government.
- 2. As per notification number HP Department of Education (2) Samkaksha (equivalence) R (205) 2015.17 dated 31.1.15 of Secy. HP Board of Education, Dharamshala a student must have passed five subjects including English as compulsory subject at Senior Secondary (plus two) level.
- 3. Admission shall not be allowed in any case to the candidates with Compartment at 10+2 level.
- 4. Admission given in the first year is provisional, subject to the confirmation by HP University. If the University cancels the admission of a candidate for whatever reason, the college will not be held responsible for it.
- 5. Admission will be on merit basis.
- 6. The students of National Institute of Open School (NIOS) who have passed all five subjects by securing requisite marks will be admitted.
- 7. The upper age limit for admission is 25 years for girls and 23 years for boy as on 1st July, 2021. Age relaxation of 2 years is allowed for ST/SC candidates.
- 8. Cultural and sports seats will be filled strictly according to the merit in sports and cultural feels. Candidates who have achieved distinction at international, national and state levels and duly verified/certified by Governmental Authorities will be given preference.
- 9. A student must appear in person on the day of admission and carry all original documents for verification. The dates of this verification will be verified as and when notified by the H.P.University/Government.

Documents Required With The Admission Form For B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. 1st Year:

- (i) Two passport size photographs.
- (ii) Self-attested photocopy of Matriculation Certificate.
- (iii) Self-attested photocopy of 10+2 Certificate. Internet copy will not be valid.
- (iv) Character Certificate.
- (v) School/college- Leaving Certificate.
- (vi) Migration Certificate for candidates who do not belong to H.P. Board/University.
- (vii) Self-attested photocopy of ST/SC/OBC/Sports/Culture/Handicapped/IRDP/BPL Certificate for those seeking relaxation in age/marks/fee etc.
- (viii) Self-attested photocopy of Bonafide Himachali Certificate (for girls only).

(ix) Aadhar number is compulsory and must be mentioned in the given column of the admission form.

Documents Required For Admission To B.A./B.COM/B.SC. 2ND & 3RD YEAR:

- (i) Certificate of the latest past examination.
- (ii) Self-attested photocopy of registration Certificate.
- (iii) Character Certificate in case of migrating candidates.

Admission Through Migration:

- (i) A student wishing to migrate to T.S.Negi Govt. College Reckongpeo will be allowed only when seats are vacant in the subject and subjects combination that are provided here.
- (ii) Procedure: on a prescribed Performa, a student has to get consent of the teachers and Principal of his/her college and the college he/she wished to migrate.
- (iii) If permission given, then two migration certificates are to be obtained by H.P. University. One of these is meant for the old college and second for the new one.A migrating student has to submit the following documents with the migration certificate:
 - a. Lecture attendance of the subjects.
 - b. Statement of credit earned under CCA.
 - c. Original Character Certificate from the Principal of college last attended.
 - d. Admission will be given during the time period provided by the H.P. University.
 - e. A student migration to T.S.Negi Govt. College Reckongpeo shall have to pay admission-fee afresh, but the monthly fee will be charged from the month of joining of the college.
 - f. A student seeking migration from a private college will also pay the annual fee.

Rejection of Admission

- 1. Admission is based on the recommendation of admission committee and from the Principal.
- 2. Those students whose behavior is found unsatisfactory shall not be given admission.
- 3. Admission shall be cancelled automatically for all those students who provide fake or wrong information or submit forged certificates.

Reservation of Seats

The Reservation is applicable to those ,who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of school Education or from any other Schools located within territorial Jurisdiction of Himachal Pradesh of Bonafide resident of Himachal Pradesh ,Sports and cultural quota will be applicable to those events which are recognized by HPU Sports and co-curricular council. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

Choosing Program Study Courses

The CBCS provides an opportunity for students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective or skill based courses. The courses can be evaluated following the grading system. The UGC has introduced uniform grading system in entire higher education in India, the cumulative grade point average(CGPA) based on students performance in examination, UGC has formulated the guidelines to be followed

Outline of Choice Based Credit System

- 1. Compulsory Course: A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Compulsory Course such as Eng/Hindi/Sanskrit(one either of two)
- 2. DSC: Discipline Specific Core, is the core course which a candidate has to study throughout the degree course in Humanities/Science/Commerce.
- 3. Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study) and and may be considered very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill
- 4. Ability Enhancement Courses: The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC). AECC courses (two) are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement. They are [(i) Environmental Science, (ii) English & Hindi/Sanskrit Language] are mandatory for all disciplines.
 - SEC courses (minimum two) are value-based and/or skill-based and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc.
- 5. An Undergraduate degree in Humanities/ Social Sciences/ Commerce may be awarded if a student completes 4 core papers each in two disciplines of choice (DSC), 2 core papers each in English and Hindi/Sanskrit (CC), respectively, 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), minimum 4 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), 2 papers each from a list of Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)papers based on the two disciplines of

- choice selected above, respectively, and two papers from the list of Generic Electives (GE) papers.
- 6. An undergraduate degree in Science disciplines may be awarded if a student completes 4 core papers each in three disciplines of choice, 2Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), minimum 4Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and 2 papers each from a list of Discipline Specific Elective papers based on three disciplines of choice selected above, respectively.
- 7. B.A/B.Sc with a particular subject would require a student to study Skill Enhancement Course of that subject (SEC's) in third year.

CBCS Three Year Degree Course

From the current session of 2018-19 Semester System in Under Graduate classes has been changed to Annual System; however the semester system shall continue for students admitted in Session 2017-18. Pass Course Credit for B.A/B. Sc/B.Com will be 132 Credits; Honour Course Credit for B.A/B. Sc/B.Com will be 148 Credits. The B.A student has to choose two Discipline Specific Courses (DSC) out of the subject combinations available and the B.Sc Students have to choose three (DSC) out of the subject combinations available.

Compartment case is allowed if a candidate is unable to pass in two subjects. The Pass Percentage is 40% in each subject including internal assessment.

Three subject pools have been formulated for humanities stream in which a student can choose a DSC I from subject pool A,B or C and DSC II from other two subject pools but two DSC's cannot be chosen from a single subject pool with an exception of Sociology where a student can choose Hindi / Sanskrit as DSC II from same subject pool.

Completion of Degree:

A regular candidate shall have to undergo the prescribed course of study in the college affiliated to the Himachal Pradesh University for a period not less than 3 years and a maximum of 5 years from the date of admission of the candidates. For completion of an undergraduate degree, the student shall have to accumulate a minimum of 132 successful credit hours of course work.

P.S.: Successful Passing of course includes Classroom Learning, Assignment Work, Mid Term Test and End Term Examination.

COURSE EVALUATION

All courses i.e. Compulsory Courses (CC) Discipline specific elective courses (DSE), Ability enhancement core course (AECC) & skill enhancement course (SEC) involves and evaluation system for the students which has the following two components

1. Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA):

Continuous Comprehensive assessment shall be carried out in the form of quizzes, assignments, group discussions, seminars, tests, attendance.

2. End Term/ Semester Examination (ESE):

- i.) The registration for ESE will be done at the time of the enrolment for the Course at the beginning of the semester. The fee for the ESE will also be collected at that time as decided by the university from time to time.
- ii.) The Student is not permitted to appear in the ESE due to shortage of attendance beyond the exemption limit (<50% attendance) shall be deemed to have 'dropped' the course. However such candidate, on his/her written request to be made immediately, can be permitted to read the missed semester after completing the rest of the programme Whenever the course is offered subsequently. This redoing would mean complete course including CCA and ESE.
- **iii.**) A student who fulfils all the requirements for appearing in a semester examination is unable to appear in the examination or to complete it on account of his/her own serious illness, accident or account of death of near relative (mother, father, brother and sister) or the date of state of national level examinations falls on dates of the semester exam may be allowed to appear in next academic year when examination for that semester is due. The permission will be permitted by college Principal/ Director on production of a valid certificate/ documents from the competent authority.

Classroom Attendance-:

- i) Each student will have to attend a minimum of 75% Lectures/ Tutorials/Practical's. A student having less that 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the End - semester Examination (ESE)
- ii) Those having between 64% and 50% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by clear reason (s) for absence to the head of the institution.
- iii) Those having between 64% and 50% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by a Medical Certificate from a Government Hospital to the head of the institution.
- iv) The exemption from 75% attendance will be given to those participating in prescribed co-curricular activities (e.g. NCC, NSS, Youth Festivals, Sports etc.) to the extent of 25% however the condition of 50% attendance will be compulsory in these cases.

The college offers following Under-Graduate courses:

- 4. Bachelor of Computer Application B.C.A (Self Financing)

ADD-ON COURSES

The college offers the following two Add-On Courses which are available only for regular students:

- 1. Environment & Disaster Management (Certificate, Diploma and Advance Diploma)
- 2. Tour & Travel Management(Certificate, Diploma and Advance Diploma)

Identity Card

- 1. Every student is directed to fill the college identity card immediately after their admission in the college.
- 2. It is mandatory for every student to keep their college identity card with themselves, while in the college campus or he/she shall be fined Rs.100/- on the spot.
- 3. Students have to show their identity card when it is sought for by any teacher, Principal or any other official of the college. Further they are strictly directed to refrain from tempering their identity card.
- 4. The students will be entertained only after the production of their college identity card. Those students who have to deal with any kind of work related to Examination, Library, Collection/ Inspection of documents etc. have to produce their identity card first, in order to establish his/her identity as a student.
- 5. It is the personal responsibility of every student to keep his/her identity card in safe custody; college will not be responsible for any misuse of one's identity card.

General Instructions for Students

- 1. It is required on the part of every student to maintain strict discipline while in the college.
- 2. Any such act which causes indiscipline will be dealt strictly.
- 3. Any kind of damage to the public property, Ragging and eve-teasing, etc. which is an offence under the law will call for legal action.
- 4. Students are directed not to temper with electric fitting, water fitting, damage to furniture, writing on the wall and desks, breaking of the window pan and flowers etc.
- 5. Use of abusive language against any student, teacher, employee and any other person in the college campus is strictly prohibited and will amount as indiscipline.
- 6. All the students are advised to read the notice board regularly and thoroughly, as all the important information and instructions relating to the students are displayed and communicated through it.
- 7. Use of mobile/cell phones is strictly prohibited in the class rooms and college campus.

INDISCIPLINARY ACTS

- 1. Disrespecting teacher or non teaching staff.
- 2. Causing damage to college property in any manner i.e. defacing, writing or breaking college furniture or property.
- 3. Using abusive language and disrupting the atmosphere of college in any manner i.e. shouting or creating nuisance in and around the college campus.
- 4. No Chewing-Gum, Drugs, Cigarettes or Alcohol are allowed in the college campus. The students in possession of these substances shall be suspended from the college.
- 5. Mobile phones are not allowed in the campus and in the classroom. The use of mobile for listening music, making call or any other mobile phone usage is

strictly prohibited. Those who are found in possession of mobile phone shall have their phones confiscated.

6. Students are expected to follow proper decorum and manners in the College.

Those having unsatisfactory behaviour shall face action against them.

Leave Rule for the students

A student can proceed on leave with prior permission, approval and sanction from the Principal with all formalities with regarding to leaves. The students are further directed to get the prior permission from the subject teacher and deposit the same to the University office in the college for the purpose respectively. The absence fine Rs. 1/- per period theory and Rs. 3/- per period for practical classes respectively. The name of the student shall also be struck off from college rolls if he/she remains absent without leave continuously for 4 days. He/she shall be readmitted with the re-admission fine of Rs. 100/- for the first time and with the fine of Rs. 200/- for second time

Personal Counseling

The college provides once a week personal counseling for students to deal with emotional stress, academic pressures, drug abuse stress or any other kind of distress experienced by students of which they are hesitant of sharing with family and friends. These personal counselling sessions are usually aimed at redirecting the student's attention towards good in life and keep them motivated for reaching their academic & personal goals.

Tutorials

Students are managed into various tutorial groups for the purpose of academic excellence and better interaction between the teacher and the taught. Teacher in charge provides assistance regarding academics and other activities periodically.

Above mentioned fees and funds can be renewed from time to time. If there are any changes

the students will be informed through notice board. Information regarding the term/time period of fees are following:

- 1. Six monthly fees will be taken during the day of admission.
- 2. Remaining six month fees and university examination fees will be taken during the month of October.
- 3. General fine will be taken before End Semester Examinations.
- 4. Fees should be paid on the decided date otherwise students name will be struck off and he/she will have to take re-admission only after paying Rs. 100/- fine.
- 5. A student who leaves the college Mid-session, their fees and other funds will not be refunded.

Scholarship for ST, SC and OBC:

- (a) The students belonging to ST or SC categories having their parent's annual income below 2.50 lakh rupees are eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- (b) Students who belong to OBC and whose parent's annual income is Rs.1 lakh or below are eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- (c) Students who belong to BPL and IRDP families are also eligible for IRDP scholarship

Fees for Persons with Disability:

The applicants with more than 40% physical disability will get relaxation in tuition fees. The applicant has to submit Medical Certificate from a competent authority and it should be

attached to the admission form.

In case of siblings studying in college under the same session/year, tuition fees of one will be exempted.

Girl's Hostel

The college has a girl's hostel with an accommodation for 60 girls. Resident girls' students are residing in the hostel since August 2015; the warden of the hostel is Asstt. Prof. Shailja Thakur Negi. The hostel is located near the college campus and is well furnished for a comfortable stay of the students. In current academic session a total of 35 students shall be admitted to the hostel strictly on the basis of academic merit the students must adhere to the rules and instructions provided as under:

General Rules of Hostel:-

- 1. A student can apply to hostel after being granted admission in the college.
- 2. The Admission forms can be availed from (College office) Mr. Ram Krishan Hostel clerk.
- 3. No ragging, smoking, drinking is allowed in the hostel, if a girl is found guilty she shall be expelled from the hostel without any prior notice.
- 4. The recommendation of warden is necessary for admission in the hostel.
- 5. A failed student shall not be allowed re-admission in the hostel.
- 6. Fresh admission needs to be sought every academic semester/year.
- 7. Any rules which may be deemed necessary by the Principal/Warden according to circumstance shall be observed by the students failing to do so may result in fine/expulsion from the hostel.
- 8. The Hostel schedule shall follow the College schedule in every manner
- 9. Security will not be refunded for the students who leave the Hostel mid session.
- 10. Married Girls are not permitted to take admission in the hostel.

Conduct Rules of Hostel

- 1. Hostel Prefect shall be deputed by Warden for one academic session, having the responsibly of discipline maintenance, conduct of boarders and shall act as representative of the boarders.
- 2. A co-operative mess and (not diet based mess) is being managed by the boarders; resident girls shall manage the mess on rotation. It is compulsory for all the boarders to join the hostel mess and be mess managers.
- 3. No visitors shall be allowed in the hostel premises without permission of authorities/warden. Parents are not allowed to visit the rooms of the residents without prior permission of the Warden.
- 4. Disciplinary action may be taken against boarders, defacing and damaging of the hostel property/furniture, which may incur fine expulsion from hostel.
- 5. The room shall be allotted at the time of admission in hostel by the authorities and one shall not be allowed to change the room without prior permission of the warden.
- 6. Leave shall be granted only for **Five days at the most** (Leave beyond days shall be granted by Principal) and residents shall not be allowed leave until guardians or parents come to receive the residents. If a resident is found absent without permission or information she shall be considered to have left the hostel and will have to seek **readmission in hostel** with prior permission of Warden and Principal.
- 7. No dues certificate from the hostel warden shall be deemed compulsory for all the outgoing boarders so as to refund their hostel security.
- 8. The hostel rules/fees are subject to change/revision and students will have to pay the revised fee structure.
- **9.** The parents of the boarders are always welcomed for valuable suggestions and visits to the hostel.

Library Rules/Book Bank

- 1. During the regular working days library will remain open from 10:00am to 5:00 pm.
- 2. At one time a student can issue two books for 15 days. If any student wants to re-issue the issued book even after 15days he/she can re-issue only after returning it first. He/she can issue the book for third time after taking permission from the Principal.
- 3. If any student does not return the book after the given duration he/she will be charged fine of one rupee per day.
- 4. If Library ID Card is lost, student can re-issue duplicate library ID card after paying Rs. 20/- fine.
- 5. In case of losing a library book, student has to pay the amount written on the book or he/she have to get the same book as compensation.
- 6. If library security fees are not withdrawn on time/decided time, it will not be refunded.
- 7. Reference book will not be issued.
- 8. Without ID card no students will enter the library.
- 9. The College library is now connected to INFLIBNET i.e N-List National Library and Information Service Infrastructure for Scholarly Content, which provides access to e-resources to colleges across India, making library digitally connected. The main objective is to share information resources amongst the libraries of academic and research institutes.

Book Bank

Excellent and adequate book facility is available in the college library. The books from the book bank are given for the full academic session to those students who belong to the strata below poverty line. The handicapped students, who are more than 40% handicapped, will be/shall be given books for the full/ whole academic year.

The students shall submit the credentials and certificate in support of the above claim duly verified by the Competent Authority not below the rank of Block development officer and District medical officer. The same shall be returned after the completion of the academic session and the annual exams. More books shall be stacked in the academic session subject to the availability of funds.

Sports

Playing Sports offers a good balance and opportunity to earn a great living while pursuing a college degree. The College encourages students to associate themselves with various sports like Boxing, Athletics, Cricket, Basketball, Volleyball, Table Tennis etc. the facilities for these sports are available in the college.

- (a) The best sports person in each academic year shall be rewarded.
- (b) A student who gets the first or the second position in various competitions will be rewarded accordingly.
- (c) The students shall also be rewarded

Who give their best and get first position in the various sports championships organized by college itself.

- (d) Participation in Inter-university sports championships shall ensure reward for the students.
- (e) Annual athletic sports meet is generally organised in the third week of the month of August.

Co- Curricular Activities

Co-Curricular activities are an integral part of an academic calendar in the institute.

The growth and over all development of the students depends upon the maximum participation of the students in different co-curricular activities. To ensure maximum participation of the student are divided into different groups and each group is given sufficient opportunity and platform to exhibit their talent. The students are given guidance and facilities to be the part of different co-curricular activities.

N.S.S.

National Service Scheme unit in our college is a very important wing as it inculcates and addresses the aspect of social responsibility in the personality of the Student. A volunteer is expected to imbibe the spirit of social service and responsibility.

Rover/Ranger

The Rover and Ranger unit is functional in our college. The Rover unit is for male students while the Ranger unit is for the female students. The membership is open for all the college students, but the same can be obtained by getting registered first. To spread the message of universal brotherhood and peace is the main purpose of the Rover and Ranger unit.

Clubs& Societies

The college has a number of clubs and societies like Red-Ribbon Club, Eco Club, Science Club, Unanti Club, Navachara/Literary Club, and Geographical Society etc. which are providing students an opportunity to participate in various Educational, Social and Cultural Activities.

Old Students Association

The college has constituted the alumni association for every pass out student of the college, the member of this association can gain membership after filling in a membership form and a nominal fee of Rs 100/- per annum. The objective of this association is to link old students with the institute so as to guide motivate the college students for a brighter future.

Parents Teacher Association

PTA is constituted every year in this college in letter and spirit in accordance to the letter no.(EDN.) 2/ Education Code/2004 on dated April 19th 2004 form the Directorate of Higher Education Shimla, H.P. Membership is mandatory for all the enrolled students in the college. A student shall deposit PTA membership fund at the time of admission. The amount of the fund is fixed by the PTA members.

Career Guidance & Counselling Cell

Realising and Keeping in view the importance of wise and judicious selection of career options at this crucial state of college life, our college has constituted a career counselling and guidance cell to guide and advise the students about the academic prospects and career opportunities.

Code of Conduct For Students:

- 1. In the college premises every student must be in possession of her valid Identity Card& must wear it throughout till she is on college premises or representing the college at any other place. Whenever demanded by the authorities concerned, the Identity Card must be produced for inspection.
- 2. Students must maintain strict discipline and decorum in the college campus.
- 3. Students should be Punctual in attending their classes.
- 4. Students are not allowed to attend classes other than their own, without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 5. Students are not permitted to bring any outsiders to the College Campus without prior permission of the Principal.
- 6. A student must attend all the tests, tutorials and examinations conducted by the College.
- 7. Every student must complete, all the academic work assigned to her class by the respective teachers, such as the completion or Practical Journal, Home Assignments, Field Diary, Project etc., in time.
- 8. No student should loiter in the corridor or college campus during lecture hours. When they are free, they should go to the library / common room / canteen. No student is permitted to miss the lectures and sit in the canteen / common room/ library.
- 9. Students are not allowed to go out of the College premises, in between the lecture periods or practicals without the permission of the Class in charge Teacher / Principal.

- 10. Every student must always be modestly dressed and observe decorum with regard to both clothing and behavior and should take utmost care not to disturb the working of her own class as well as that of others. For self-financing courses students will have uniform approved by the management.
- 11. Students are not allowed to organize picnics/ activities without prior permission of the Principal.
- 12. No student shall collect any money as contribution towards picnics, trips, educational visits, get together, study-notes, charity or any other activity without the prior permission of the College Principal.
- 13. Every student should take utmost care of the college property to keep the College premises neat, tidy and clean for the common welfare of all. Any willful damage to the property of the College will be dealt with as breach of discipline and is liable for punishment. Such incidences should promptly be reported to the College Principal.
- 14. Students are requested to take care of their own property. The College Authorities are not responsible for the loss of any personal belongings of the students.
- 15. Students should deposit any lost property found by them in the College Office. Such incidences are displayed on the Notice Board. Owners of lost property should enquire and claim the same from the office.
- 16. If a student remains absent without giving a leave application for sizable length of time, her name is liable to be removed from the College rolls.
- 17. Students who fail to maintain the condition of minimum attendance on account of bonafide illness, or any other reason which is deemed right by the Principal, should apply in writing to the Principal for leave of absence, prior or

within 2 days from the date of commencement of such leave, failing which they will be treated as defaulters. Application forms are available within or 2 days after joining back (in case of illness) in our office.

- 18. Absence of the student on valid grounds at lectures/ practicals / tutorials / tests/ examinations must be communicated to the College Principal immediately in writing with the necessary supporting documents viz. Medical certificate etc. through the respective class teacher.
- 19. Students who request leave of absence from lectures/practical/tutorials for participation in sports, games, cultural or any other activities for and on behalf of the College/ Activity group, should submit the applications countersigned by the respective Teacher -in-charge before the commencement of such leave, failing which they will be treated as defaulters.
- 20. Parents/ Guardians if accompanying students should sign the visitors register at the gate and maintain decorum in the college.
- 21. All other relatives are directed to obtain written permission from the principal if they want to represent any student.
- 22. Parents of students are requested to kindly contact the Teacher-in-charge of class, Head of Department, Principal, at least once in a term, to keep themselves in touch with their ward's attendance and progress.
- 23. Counseling center and Mentor System: It has been observed that some of the students have personal problems, causing stress and strain. The college has appointed a councilor to help such students to cope with these problems. The students/ parents are requested to make use of this facility. All matters will be kept confidential. The college has also set up mentor System having teacher mentor to guide the students in their difficulties. In case of any problem, personal

or academic, students should report to the teacher-in-charge Mentor teacher who will help them solve their problems.

- 24. No society, association, committee, organization of students should be formed in the College without the sanction of the Principal.
- 25. Outsiders should not be invited to address any meeting or to participate in any college activity without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 26. A teacher conducting a class at a given time shall be in absolute control of the class, and may take appropriate action in order to maintain discipline in the class.
- 27. Any member of the teaching or non-teaching staff may intervene on the spot to deal with disorderly/ destructive activities on the part of the students either in the class room or outside the class room in the College premises.
- 28. Any matter not covered by the rules and regulation in vogue and/or notified through notices, circular, prospectus etc., will rest at the absolute discretion of the Principal. The right of interpretation of any rule is reserved by the Principal.
- 29. All rules and regulations enforced and implemented by the college / Management / U.G.C / University / Government from time to time will remain binding on students.
- 30. Any cost incurred by the college on account of communication owing to indiscipline/default of attendance / not appearing for mandatory internal examinations / viva / not submitting projects by students / any other matters pertaining to college administration related to students will be recovered from the concerned student.

RAGGING: A PUNISHABLE OFFENCE

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING UNDER H.P. EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION ACT

(PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT ,2009) defines 'Ragging' as doing any act, by disorderly conduct, to a student of an educational institution ,which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to the student.

Such disorderly conduct includes, teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student, will not be willing to do in the ordinary course

A student who commits the offence of ragging shall be punishable with a imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years or shall also be liable to the fine which may extend Rs.50,000/- or both.

If a student is convicted of the charges of committing, abetting, participating or propagating ragging, he shall be dismissed from the college and such student will not get admission in any other college for a period of three years from the date of his dismissal from the college
